

PROPHECY OF JONAH

This is excuse for 1988

Christ Ahnsahnghong proclaimed destruction in 1988, but destruction didn't come. Let's look at the prophecy of Jonah.

Matthew 25:1-10

The ten Virgins. Some people fell away. God does this to find His true children.

Matthew 12:38-41

3 days in the heart of Earth =Jesus' 1^{st} coming. This is the only miracle He will perform for them to believe. There are 2 prophesies for 1^{st} and 2^{nd} coming Christ. His 1^{st} coming: see **vs. 40**

- 1) Crucified
- 2) 2) In the tomb
- 3) Resurrection.

Christ. His 2nd coming: see **vs. 41**

- 1) Whoever fulfills at the Day of Judgment the last day Just like the people of Nineveh who repented from the preaching of Jonah. They were spared. Destruction was to come to the people of Nineveh in 40 days.
- 2) One greater than Jonah is here (meaning 2nd coming Christ)

How was this fulfilled?

Jonah 1:1-3, 17

Because of the wickedness of the people, God was going to destroy the people

Jonah 3:1-4

He preached destruction in 40 days, but it didn't come. Why? They repented.

VS: 10 No destruction

2000 years ago- destruction came, (to the Israelites) so Jesus didn't fulfill this- 2^{nd} coming Christ must fulfill this.

Father was baptized in 1948 + 40 = 1988 40 years came; 1988 but there was no destruction, at this time many brothers & sisters fell away.

God always wants to save His people. Since the people of the world repented the destruction never came.

Jonah 4:10-11

God wants to save us-through this many people realized and repented and came to God.

Ezekiel 18: 21-28

VS: 23 never forget this teaching. God does not take pleasure in the death of the wicked.

Matthew 24: 44-51

Always be faithful.
