When	Friday, October 19th, 2012 @ 9:00am-2:00pm
Where	Initial Meeting will be at Queens Zion (subject to change, depending on City Meals on Wheels).
Purpose	<p>This event aims to raise awareness of global hunger and its presence in the state of New York where on a daily basis more than 2,500 people are turned away at soup kitchens and pantries due to lack of provisions. Despite the grim facts, this event is a continuation of The Movement: "Mother's Love Feeds the Hungry," where WeLoveU volunteer members are personally delivering approximately 20,000 pounds of canned food to the doorsteps of NYC families in greatest need.</p> <p>Friday, 10/19/2012 is the second of four drop-offs in which we are partnering with CityMealsOnWheels to deliver 3,000 of the 20,000 lbs of canned food that we collected during the Good Samaritan Movement (COG gave to WeLoveU). We will be delivering this portion to elderly impoverished seniors who have very low retirement income, government support, or family help.</p> <p>The purpose of this event is to display the love of the chairwoman Zahng Gil Jah to the seniors we meet. Our goal is to interact with the seniors in a gracious way, allowing them to feel Mother's love and produce a fragrance of Zion.</p>
Attire	WeLoveU T-Shirts, Jeans and Sneakers (to accomadate a lot of walking)
How	There are a total of 100 Houses that need to be visited for the day. Based upon the number of volunteers available will determine the number of teams (&cars) taken. Each car will have their own specific route that will be given to them during the meeting at 9:30 am with CityMeals on Wheels. The route will include a map that will indicate which houses and addresses each car is to visit. In each car there will be 1 assigned driver and runners who will be delivering the food.
Functions	<p>Drivers: Drivers are responsible for following the route map that is given to them. Upon arrival @ each location on the map, the driver is to wait in the car for the members delivering the food in case the car needs to be moved, there is no parking, etc. The driver will be considered leader of each car & is responsible for communication between that car & either Saira/Rebecca.</p> <p>Runners: Runners are responsible for delivering the food to the Senior Citizens' Houses, providing photo waivers and taking clear pictures of senior citizens (who have signed waiver) with WeLoveU members.</p>
Do's & Don'ts	There can not be ANY mention of Church or any religious affiliation. We can NOT give anybody any paraphernalia from our Church. We cannot mention the Church of God. We are solely WeLoveU Foundation. Each house is allotted 20 minutes. Some houses will not want to spend any time with you. If that is the case, just drop the food off and move on.
